<b>Mark Rounding Order</b>

Finish	After rounding Stretcher Mark the number of times indicated on the rounds board on the committee boat, Mark 3 (to port), and Proceed directly to the Finish Line.						

**Marks 1, Mark 2 and 3 are Orange Cylindrical buoys and the Stretcher Mark is a Dan Buoy. A vessel with a staff carrying an orange flag will be used for the port end Start Mark and the Finish Mark will be a Dan Buoy.**
