

2000 Class 20th Anniversary National Championships, and Festival of Sailing

August 10th - 16th 2019

Information sheet

The 2000 Class will be celebrating its 20th anniversary in 2019, and will be marking the occasion with a festival of sailing at the wonderful venue of Tenby in South Wales.

The following information has been compiled from a variety of sources, although the Class Association cannot be held liable for any inaccuracies.

1. Camping is available at a local school from £10 per night. There are toilet and shower facilities. The school is about 8-10 minutes walk from the centre of town.
2. Accommodation is available at a nearby outdoor centre. They have about 80 beds in a combination of twin or family rooms at Llanion Cove, 15 minutes from Tenby, with free parking & trailer storage. Accommodation is priced at around £20-£25 per person per night. A link to the accommodation page is below, so please contact them directly for bookings & prices.

We are currently discussing catering options with the Clubs usual caterer, but anticipate at least 2 evening meals being included for competitors (2 per boat), and including a welcome Sailing Supper on the Saturday you arrive, following the success of this in 2018. The Friday night prize giving dinner will require separate tickets, again as per previous years. Further details on all catering options will be released as soon as confirmed.
4. Road trailer parking at the local comprehensive school at £8 for the week. Trailers storage is not available at the sailing club.
5. Parking is at a premium in Tenby in the summer, and there is no parking at the sailing club. There are a number of car park options. These can be found at <https://www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk/tenby-car-parks/tenby-multi-storey>. The largest is the town centre multi storey that is a short walk to the sailing club. Weekly tickets can be purchased for £20.
