Dear Young Sailor (and Parents),

We are pleased to welcome you to TSC Young Sailors Programme 2006. Tenby Sailing Club has a long tradition of training both young and adult sailors from the absolute beginners through to club members who have competed at the highest level (UK European and World Level).

For 2006 the training will be structured into three progressive stages:

- Junior Sail Training (Weekly on Wednesday - late afternoon)
- Junior Race Training (Fortnightly on Saturday – late afternoon)
- Junior Club Racing (Weekly on Wednesday – early evening and Sunday mornings)

In addition, and in partnership with Pembrokeshire Watersports we are able to offer RYA level 1 & 2 courses for a number of junior sailors each year. Beyond this we actively encourage our young sailors to follow clearly defined pathways into Regional, Welsh and UK training and events. (Please see relevant sections for further details).

These training sessions can only take place due to the hard work of a dedicated group of unpaid volunteers. But they cannot do it alone and it is expected that all sailors and parents give assistance whenever help is required. Guidance and training for parents will be given throughout. Whatever level you are currently at, we are sure you will find sailing exciting and above all FUN! on some of the best sailing waters in the UK.

Finally once you're initial taster sessions are over, we hope you will become a club member (£5 p.a. per Junior) and join in the fun at TSC.

# Legal Details

**i.e. Boring Stuff**

- Young Sailors and Parents are considered to be guests of Tenby Sailing Club for the Initial Taster Sessions (maximum 3 sessions).
- Thereafter, it is a requirement of the Club rules, that each young sailor becomes a member of Tenby Sailing Club (cost £5.00 pa/free to children of Tenby Sailing Club full members).
- Each young Sailor remains the responsibility of the parent throughout the session, except when under direct supervision of an Instructor either on shore or on the water.
- Parents are considered guests of the Tenby Sailing Club for the duration of each session only. If you wish to join in social functions then you must be formally signed in as a guest.
